POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- Workshop curriculum; All workshops are designed to provide a positive, moral / value-based outlet of expression in the Arts to encourage creativity that assist to define potential, develop confidence and build a healthy self esteem. As applicable, techniques for Acting, Singing, Songwriting, Playwriting, Movement for stage (Dance) – Mime etc., will be explored while incorporating inspirational themes and music to promote a wholesome environment of encouragement and performance excellence for stage and life.
- Workshop registration and fees must be received prior to class attendance; all materials and performance costs are included, unless otherwise noted.
- Workshop final performances will conclude each workshop; student participation in performance may be limited if absences exceed 1.
- Workshop performance attire: Performance T-Shirt (**provided**), Blue Jeans and White Tennis Shoes (unless otherwise noted)
- There are no class make-ups, refunds or credits after the workshop session begins; however, due to inclement weather, make-up classes and / or additional rehearsal classes may be determined as needed.
- Workshop Field Trips – for certain locations, field trips are coordinated to performing arts-related events and shows. Parental consent forms will be provided for details in advance and participation.
- Workshops are subject to cancellation; If student enrollment is not met at applicable locations
- Workshop Disciplinary Guidelines; Students are encouraged to refrain from the use of negative language (cursing, slander, derogatory comments etc.) and inappropriate behaviors (obscene use of body movements etc.). Students are strongly motivated to use positive expressions that promote an inspiring, wholesome and value-building environment and will be given a maximum of 3 warnings per class for any continuing behaviors or language deemed inappropriate: **1st Warning – Verbal, 2nd Warning -Verbal and Time Out (away from group or activity), 3rd Warning - Parent/ Instructor Conference & Evaluation**
To protect the welfare of ALL class participants and maintain the integrity of this workshop, ***If a student shows no willingness to refrain from inappropriate behavior, they may be dismissed from the workshop.*** No registration or session fees will be refunded.
